COMMITTEE BUSINESS

1. Ordinance No. 2828 - Parking Code Amendments

Mr. Ryan Windish, Community Development Director presented Ordinance No. 2828 explaining that it would amend the City of Sumner Parking Code to allow school bus parking on the southside of Mason Street and remove the RPZ 1 designation because the new Sumner High School expansion will have bus parking in this location. This was in response to a request by the Sumner-Bonney Lake School District. Furthermore, the Parking Code amendments would prohibit parking on the south side of 45th Street East in a section 350 feet east of Tacoma Avenue to reduce congestion and increase maneuverability for commercial trucks creating a safer roadway.

The CD Committee unanimously approved a "do pass" recommendation to the City Council.
