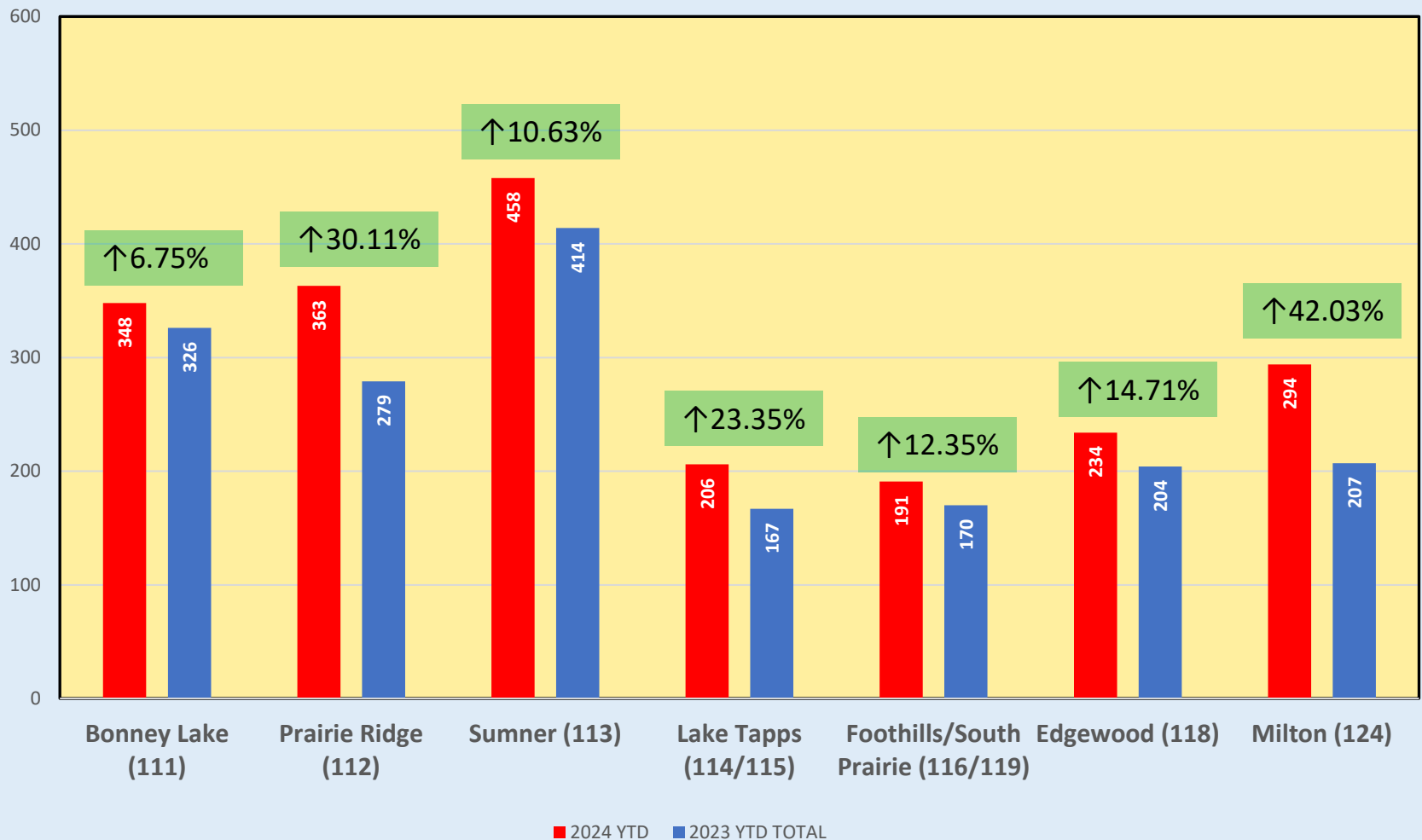


Incident Count by Station Area—YTD 2024

Severe weather event January 12-17 accounted for some of the increase

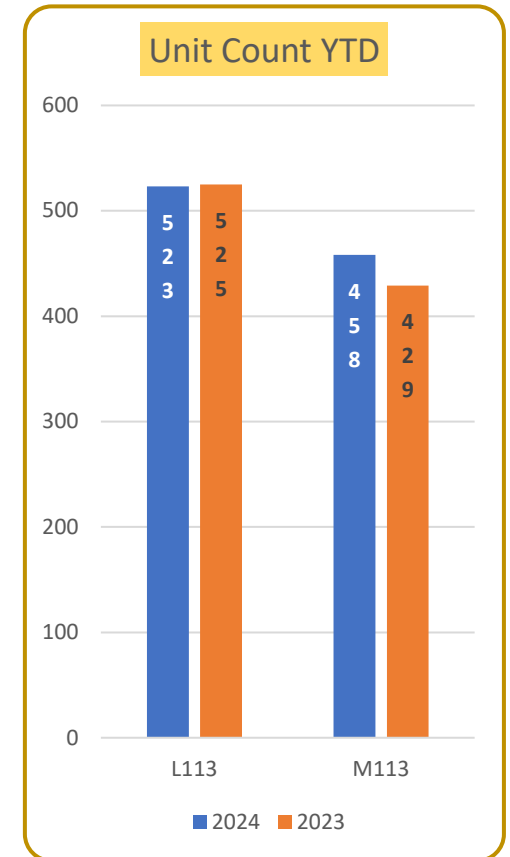

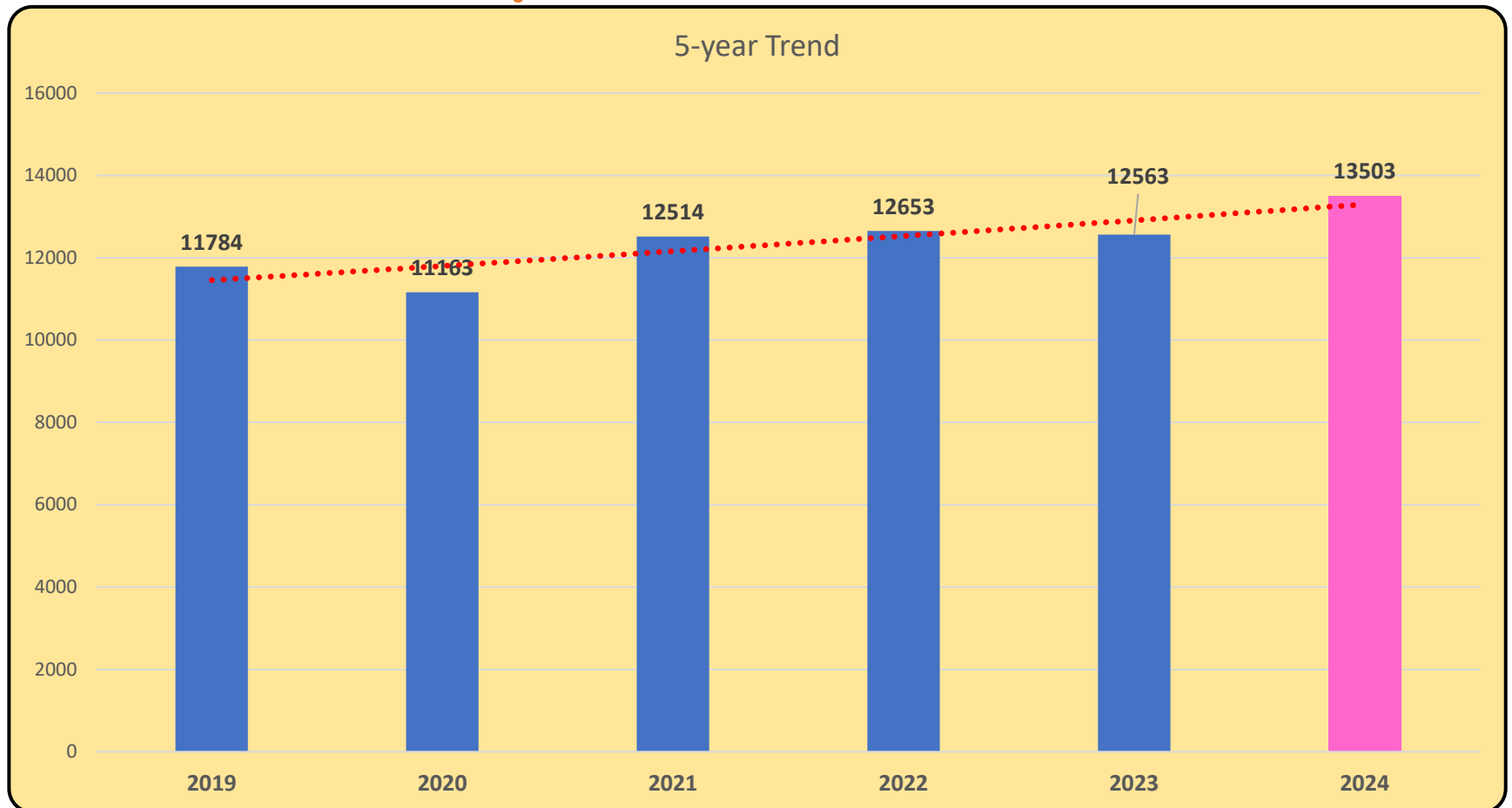

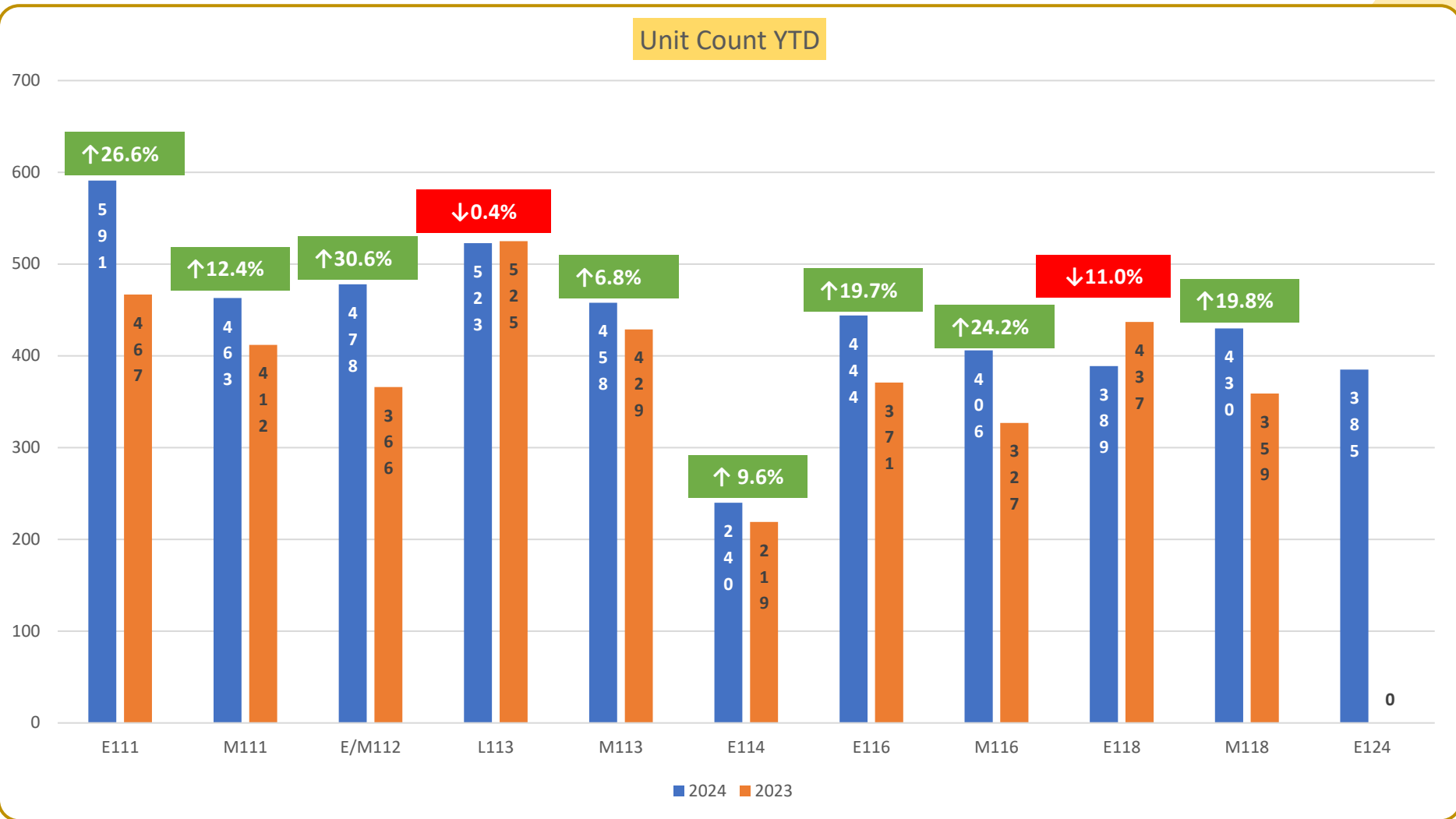
L113 showed a 0.4% decrease from last year.
