SUMMARY BACKGROUND:

Washington Street between Wood Avenue and McMillan Avenue, approximately 500 linear feet of a two-lane collector street, has experienced significant distress and is in need of replacement. Additionally, the underground utilities (water, sewer, storm) are in need of replacement due to age. This presentation describes the extent of need and recommends appropriating design funds in 2024 so that the roadway and utilities could be reconstructed in Summer 2025.

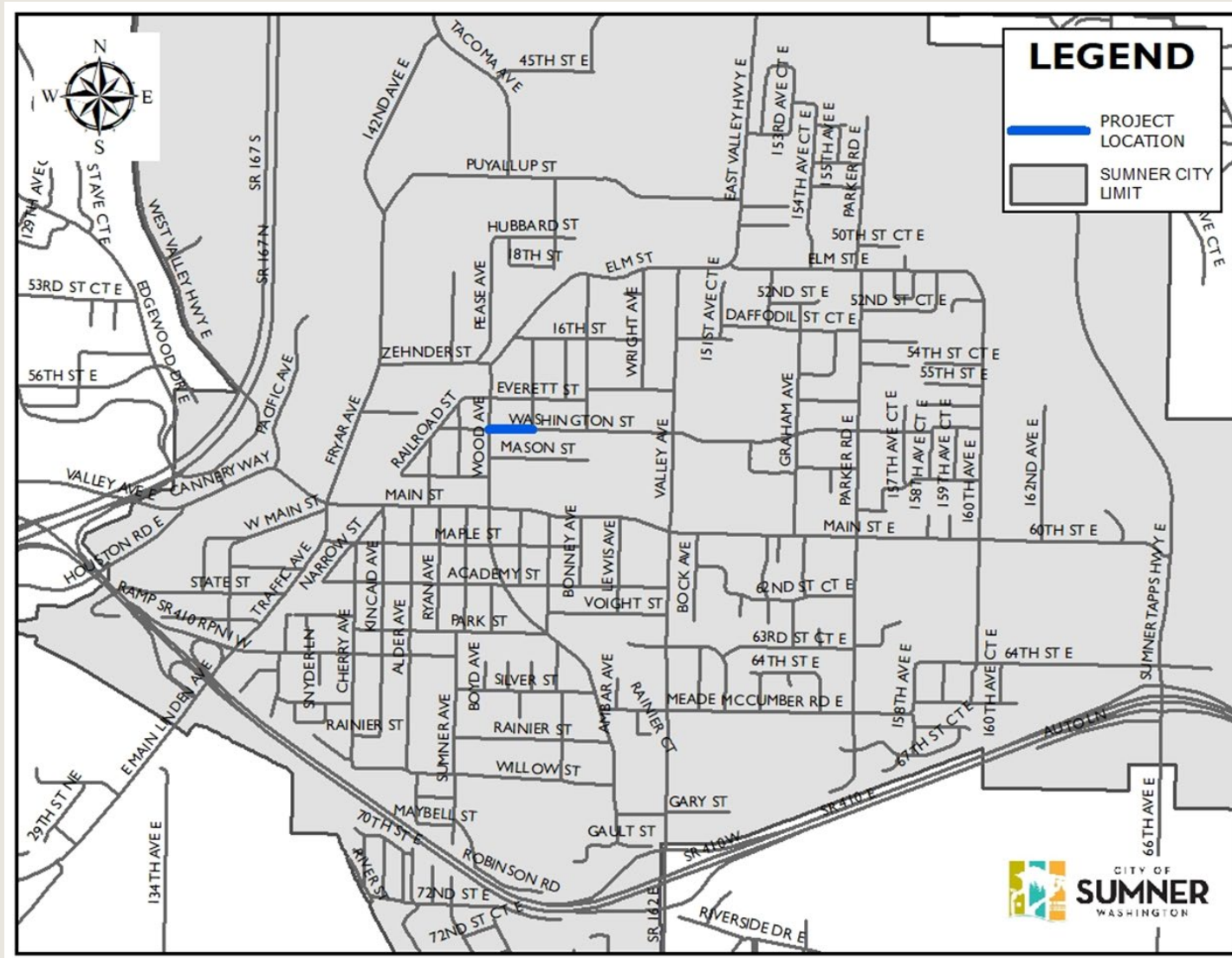

EXISTING UTILITIES

- Sanitary Sewer in Washington St. built in 1914 and 1922 needs to be replaced.
 - Pipe material and spacing
 - Infiltration and Inflow concerns
- Water is undersized and has minimal separation from Sanitary Sewer that does not meet our current City standards.
 - Pipe material and spacing
 - Will upsize from 6" to 8" to meet City standards

PURPOSE/NEED

- Increase traffic and pedestrian safety
- Construct infrastructure that addresses current needs
- Maintain and manage roadway surface and utilities to highest standards

All of this helps to maximize taxpayer's investment in their infrastructure.

SOLUTION



- Full Roadway Reconstruction, including curb, gutter, and sidewalks
- Full Sanitary Sewer Replacement
- Full Water Distribution Replacement
- Full Storm Drainage Replacement

Design: \$300,000

Construction: \$2,224,000 (including tax and contingency)

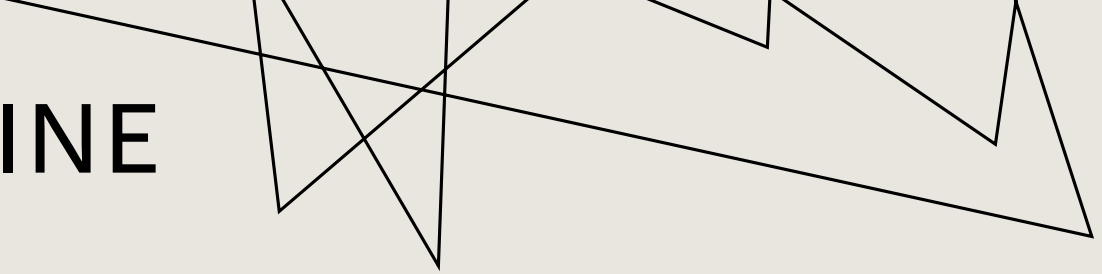
