The following topics were discussed:

PSE Energy Savings Grant Acceptance

Associate City Engineer Van Gilder stated the City of Sumner was invited to participate in an energy savings program sponsored by Puget Sound Energy. Staff attended several seminars with energy savings experts and other industry members. The Sumner Wastewater Treatment Facility has already accomplished the first two incentives, and therefore can collect \$2K of the overall \$18K grant.

Councilmember Neuman recused herself due to a business relationship with PSE. *“Do- Pass Recommendation by the Committee”*

2021-2022 On Call Consultant Services Contract Award

Associate City Engineer Van Gilder stated last month he presented the 2021-2022 On Call Consultant contracts for approval. One consultant, LDC, Inc., was inadvertently omitted and needs to be added to this list. *“Do- Pass Recommendation by the Committee”*

WWTF NPDES Permit & Pretreatment Program

Director Dahlem and Pretreatment Coordinator Swann presented a Power Point (attached) to the Committee on the WWTF Discharge Permit Reissuance. The City has been operating with an expired permit for 6 years, while awaiting the Department of Ecology to write a new permit. The new permit was effective March 1st, 2021 and is active for 5 years. Items discussed were loading limits, BOD limits, testing requirements, contributing jurisdiction (Bonney Lake) and Pretreatment Program Delegation.

Director Dahlem briefed the Committee on projects.

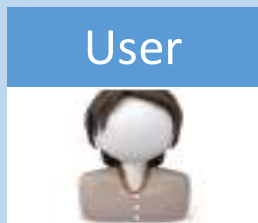
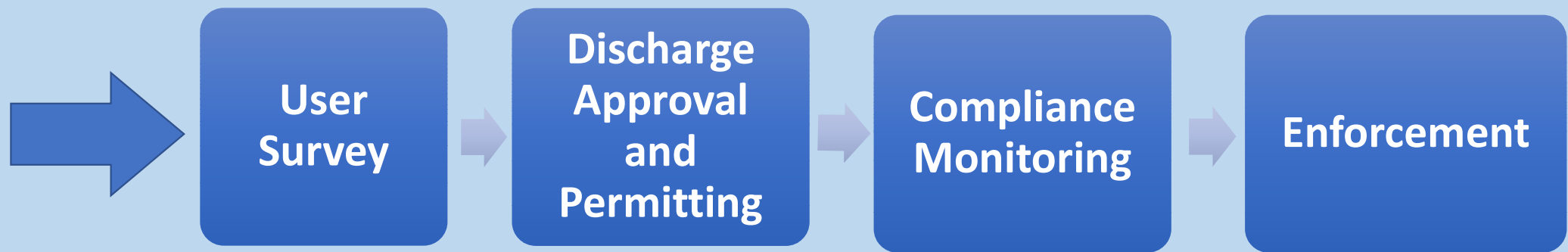

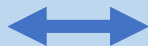
