

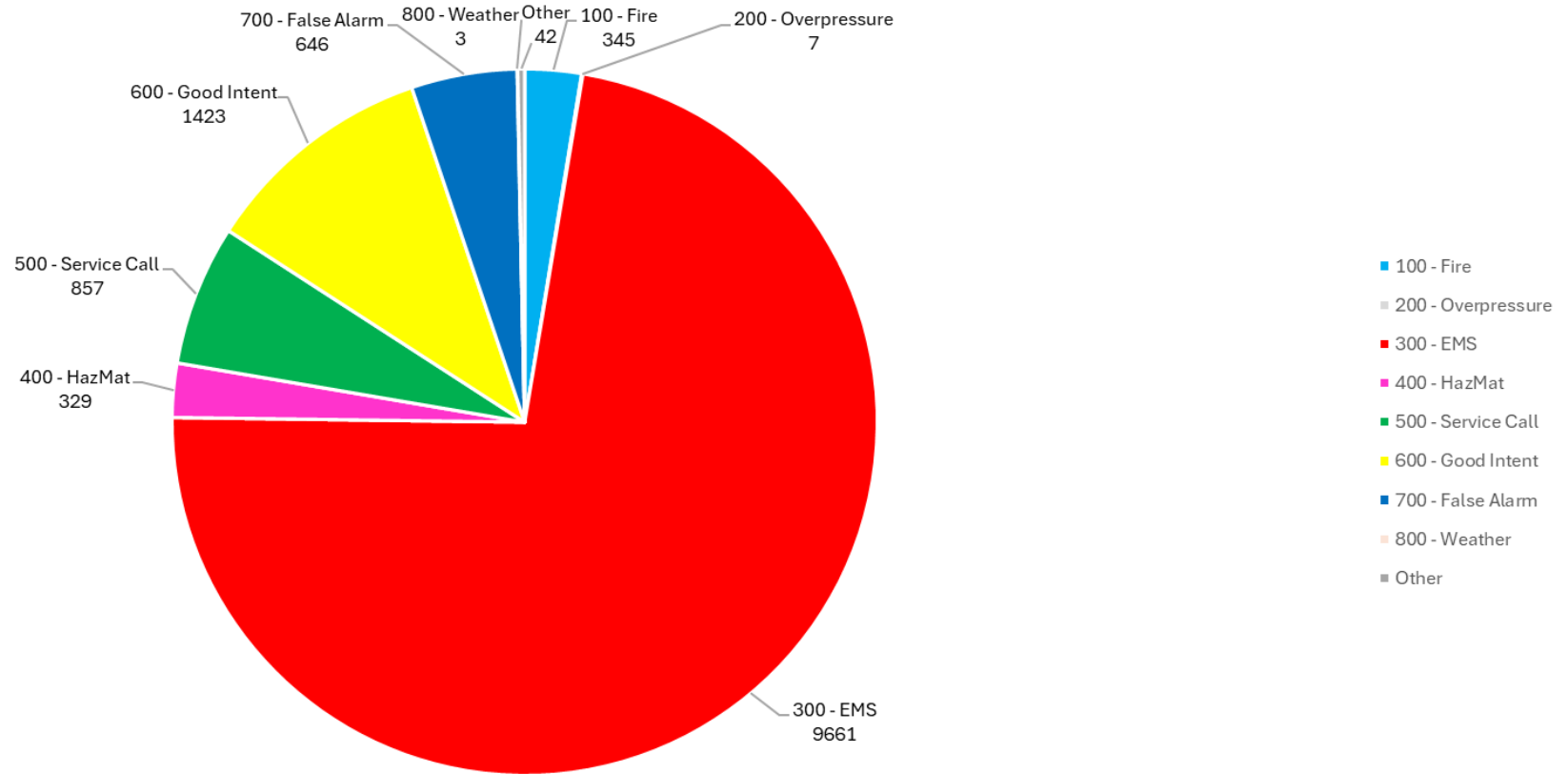

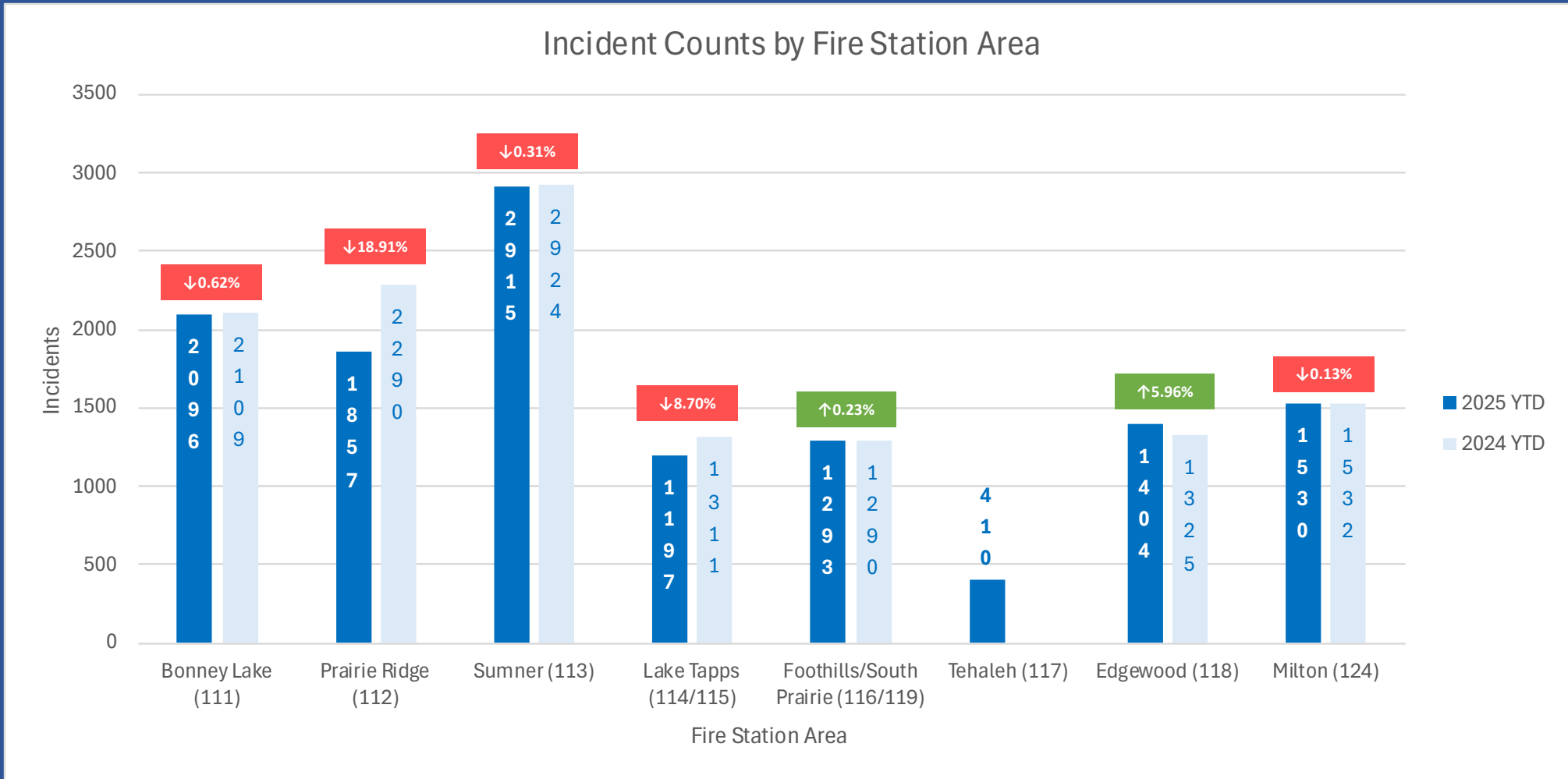

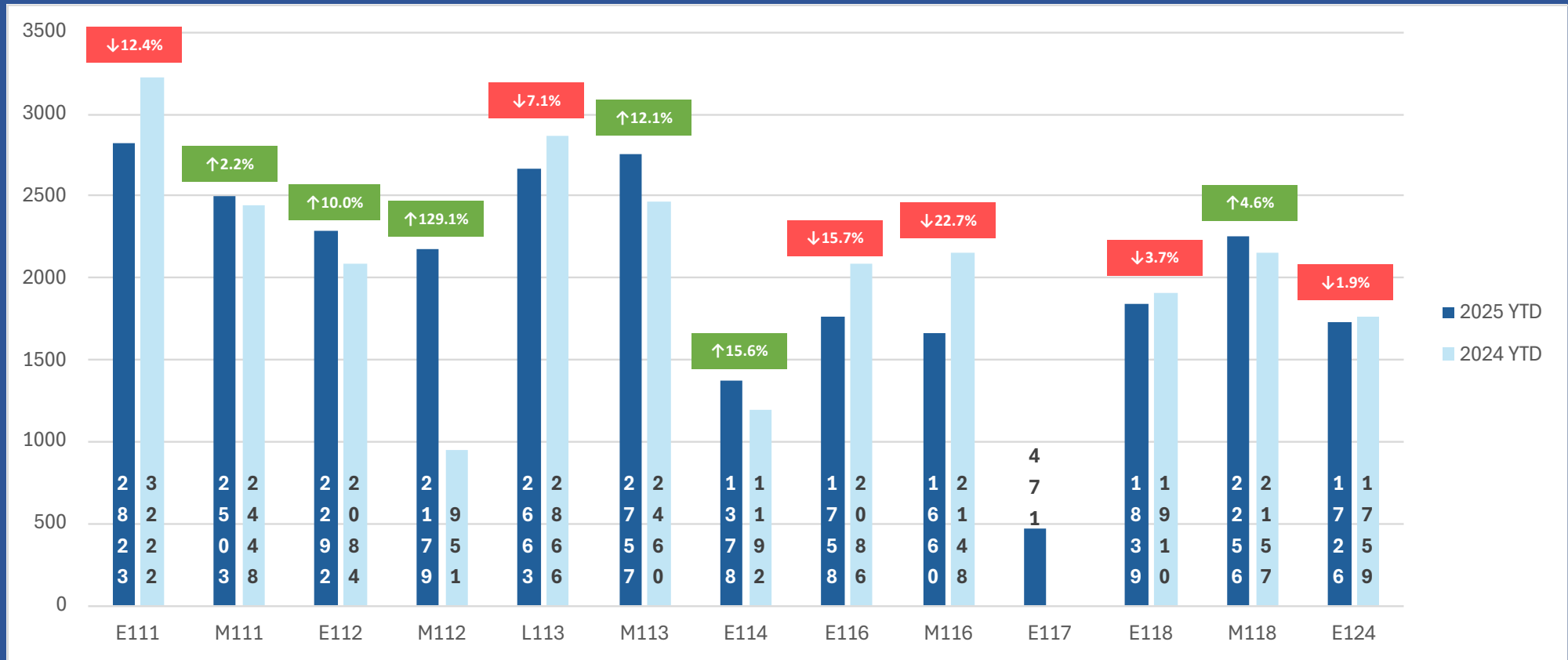
# Incident Count by Fire Station Area – YTD – 2024 vs. 2025

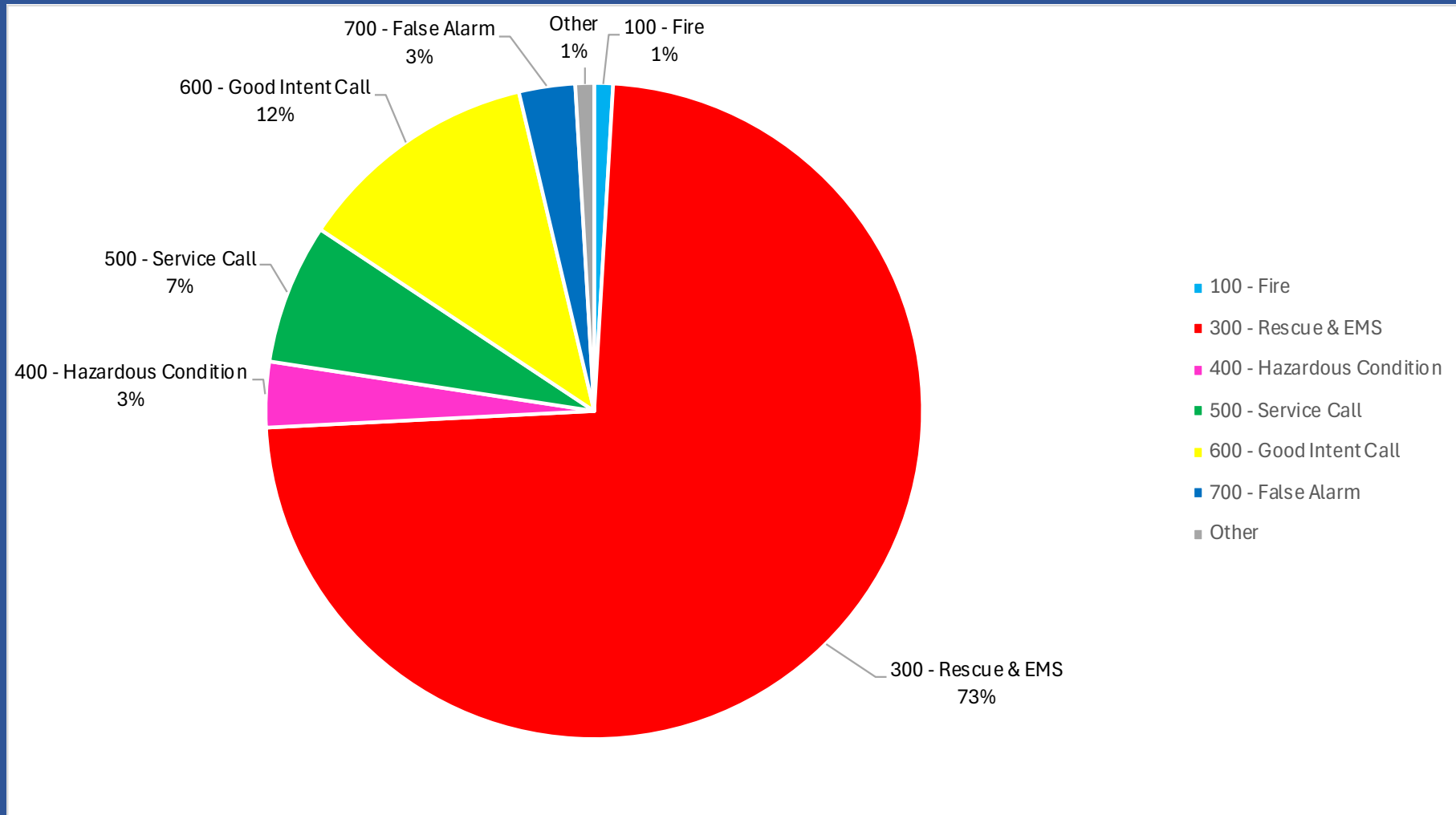

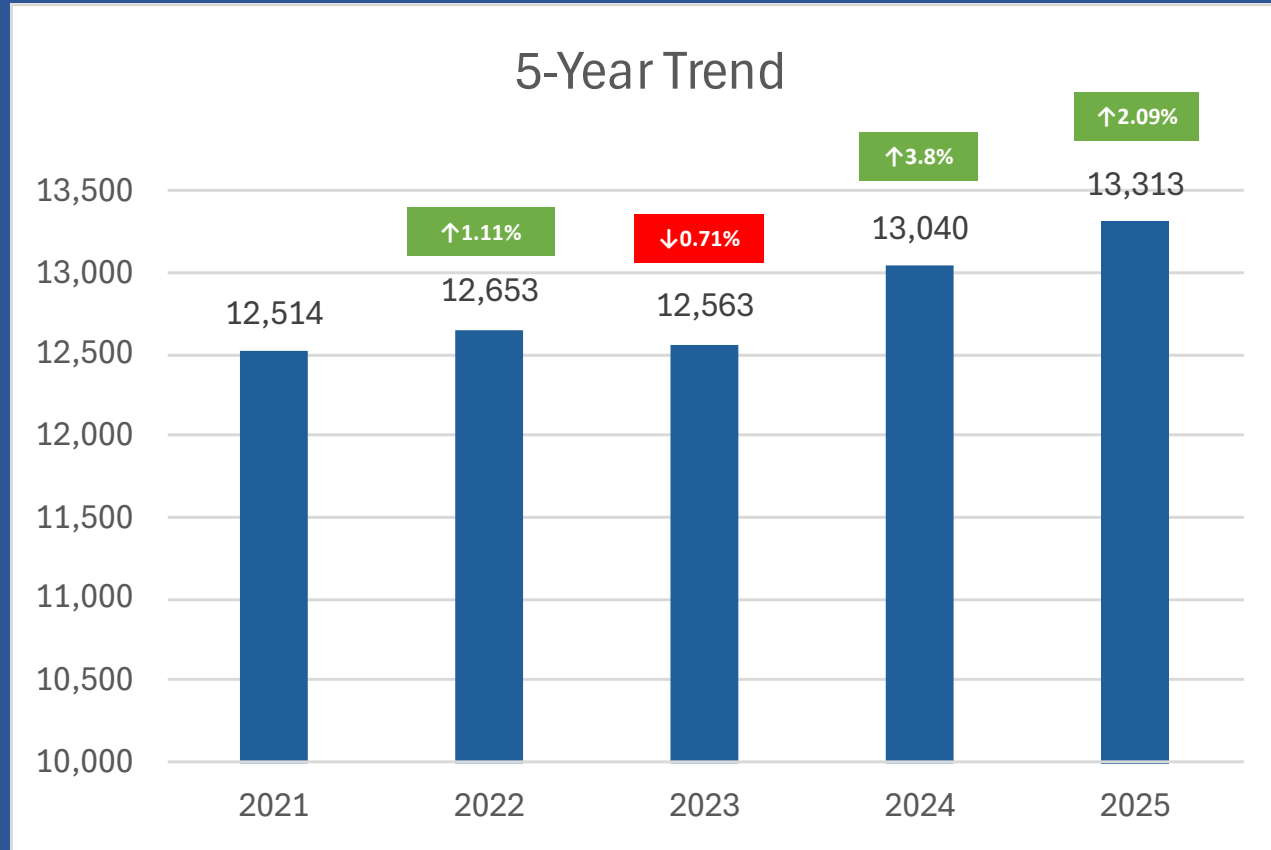
