MONTHLY REPORTS AND DEPARTMENT UPDATES - FIRE

RECOGNITION OF LOSS OF COMMITTEE AND COUNCIL MEMBER, GREG REINKE WHO PASSED AWAY EARLIER THIS WEEK. RECRUIT CLASS GRADUATING TOMORROW WITH 13 NEW FIREFIGHTERS. WILL HAVE A NEW CLASS STARTING IN JANUARY OF 2027. WILDFIRE SEASON HAS KICKED OFF IN EASTERN WASHINGTON ALREADY WHICH MEANS WE MAY HAVE A BUSY SEASON AS WELL. 4TH OF JULY IS ON A SATURDAY THIS YEAR, WE TYPICALLY SEE DOUBLE OUR DAILY CALL VOLUME ON THIS HOLIDAY. ABOUT A MONTH AFTER THE HOLIDAY WE SHOULD BE ABLE TO LOOK AT THE STATS SPECIFICALLY IN SUMNER OVER THE HOLIDAY. NO SUBSTANTIAL MONTHLY TRENDS TO REPORT CURRENTLY. NATIONAL FRAMEWORK FOR CODING INCIDENTS HAVE RECENTLY CHANGED AND HAVE CHANGED HOW WE REPORT OUR STATS. ACROSS THE DISTRICT IN THE CITY OF SUMNER, NO SUBSTANTIVE DIFFERENCE OR CHANGE AS WE HEAD INTO SUMMER AND 4TH OF JULY, INCIDENTS MAY PICK UP. THERE WILL BE A NEW SLIDE IN YOUR STATS WHICH IS BROKEN OUT INTO DIFFERENT CATEGORIES. RESCUE = MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS, HAZSITS = NATURAL GAS LEAKS ARE TWO OF THE NEW ONES YOU MAY SEE. I WILL SEND STATS TO BE POSTED AFTER THE MEETING.

1. Monthly Stats for May 2026

MAY 2026 STATS PRESENTED. TOTAL CAD EVENTS ARE UP, REPORTS ARE UP, COLLISIONS ARE DOWN, TRAFFIC STOPS AND TICKETS ISSUED ARE STANDARD ACROSS THE BOARD, DISCUSSION ABOUT LEGAL FIREWORKS IN THE CITY ON THE 4TH. ONLINE REPORTING WILL BE AVAILABLE UNLESS THERE IS IMMEDIATE THREAT TO LIFE/PROPERTY. WE HAVE ONE OFFICER FINISHING UP HIS FIELD TRAINING. WE ARE TRYING TO HIRE A NEW OFFICER, BUT HAVE NOT HAD ANY QUALIFIED APPLICANTS. WE DO HAVE TWO OPENINGS AND A POSSIBLE UPCOMING RETIREMENT. WE HAVE A NEW OFFICER WHO WILL BE STARTING IN AUGUST AND WILL START THE ACADEMY IN SEPTEMBER. WE ARE IN THE BUDGET PROCESS FOR 2027/2028 AND IT IS POSSIBLE WE WILL ASK FOR FUNDING FOR TWO NEW OFFICER POSITIONS OVER THE NEXT TWO YEARS.

ACTION ITEMS

1. AXON Police Technology Contract 2026-2030 (revised contract 6/16/2026)

OUR AXON CONTRACT IS UP FOR RENEWAL FOR BODY CAMERAS AND TASERS. WE ARE LOOKING AT SIGNING A 5 YEAR CONTRACT WITH AXON. THIS CONTRACT WILL GIVE US 27 BODY CAMERAS AND TASERS, WHICH SHOULD COVER OUR UPCOMING NEW HIRES WE ARE

PLANNING ON IN 2027/2028. THIS ALSO INCLUDES THE LICENSES FOR OUR INTERVIEW ROOMS AND PUBLIC DISCLOSURE REQUESTS. LOOKING FOR A DO PASS ON THE PROPOSED CONTRACT SO WE CAN BRING IT TO COUNCIL ON JULY 6TH. ALL PRESENT MEMBERS GAVE THE PROPOSED AXON CONTRACT A DO PASS. THIS ITEM WILL BE FORWARDED TO THE COUNCIL ON JULY 6TH.

2. Police Radio Replacement Contract

WE ARE LOOKING AT PURCHASING 30 MOTOROLA RADIOS, WE WILL NOT NEED TO PURCHASE NEW BATTERIES OR CHARGERS, AS WE CAN UTILIZE OUR CURRENT ONES. THE RADIOS WE CURRENTLY HAVE ARE BEING PHASED OUT AND MOTOROLA WILL NO LONGER SERVICE THEM, SO WE NEED TO REPLACE THEM. A PORTION OF THE COST WILL BE PAID BY A SURPLUS OF FUNDS WE WILL RECEIVE BACK FROM SS911. THE RADIO UPGRADE WILL ALSO ALLOW US TO TALK TO OUR CITY'S PUBLIC WORKS CREWS AND OTHER EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT CHANNELS. LOOKING FOR A DO PASS TO BRING THIS TO COUNCIL JULY 20TH.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

DISCUSSED THE PULSE POINT APP AND WHAT IT DOES.

WE WILL NEED TO VOTE ON A CHAR TO REPLACE GREG. MICHAEL HOCHSTATTER NOMINATES NICOLE WILSEY TO BE THE CHAIR.

NICOLE MENTIONED SUBJECTS ARE HIDING IN THE BUSHES BEHIND A BUSINESS IN HOPS ALLEY, THEY ARE NOW AWARE OF WHERE THE CAMERAS ARE AND ARE STILL LOITERING THERE AND HIDING JUST OUT OF CAMERA VIEW. THEY WERE SEEN AROUND 10 PM, AND 1-3AM. DEPUTY CHIEF HOUSELOG WILL ADVISE PATROL TO KEEP AN EYE ON THIS.

DISCUSSION ABOUT RHUBARB DAYS AND EXTRA OFFICERS WILL BE ON DUTY AND ROAD CLOSURES. SIGNS HAVE GONE UP ALREADY FOR NO PARKING AND BARRICADES ARE BEING SET OUT ALREADY. THERE WILL BE OUTSIDE SECURITY HIRED FOR AFTER HOUR SHIFTS WHEN EVENT ENDS AT 9PM. PUYALLUP PD WILL BRING THEIR NEW EXPLOSIVES K9 TO WALK THE EVENT TOO.
