1. July 2026 data review

Chief Parkinson presented stats for July. No significant changes for the month or year.

1. Discussed Reinke's memorial and appreciation from his family for support from the city, council, and community.
2. Wildfires on east side of state increasing and now locally as well. Units are out assisting on multiple wildfire events in WA and OR (currently a brush truck and 4 personnel deployed as well as "single resources" as requested).
3. Burn ban increased to Stage 2- backyard burning (already not allowed in city) banned in unincorporated and recreational fires banned. Essentially only BBQ's allowed.
4. Station in Prairie Ridge almost complete.
5. Firefighter recruitment continues.
