

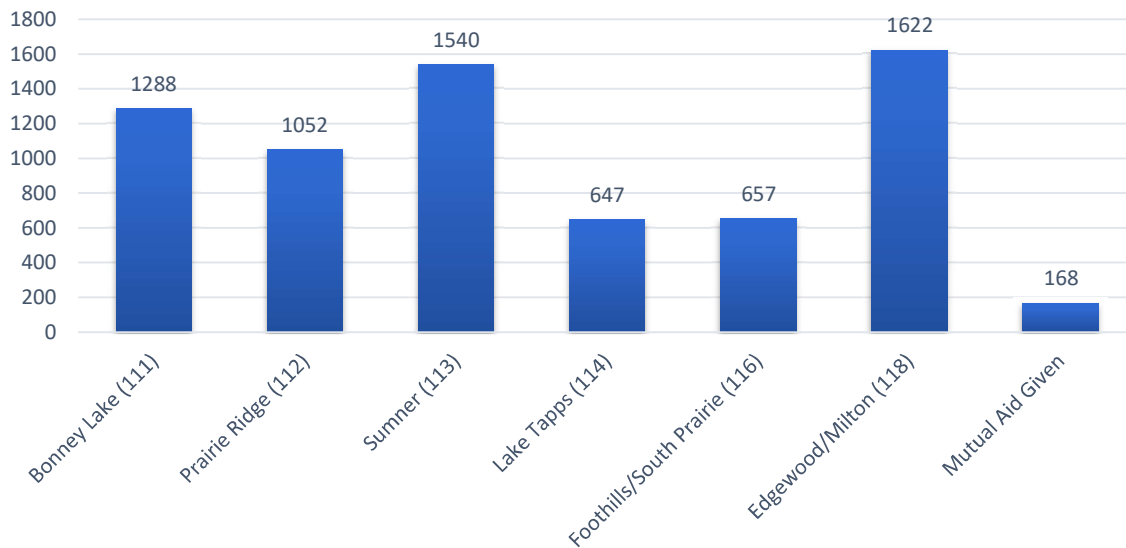

Incidents by response area - YTD

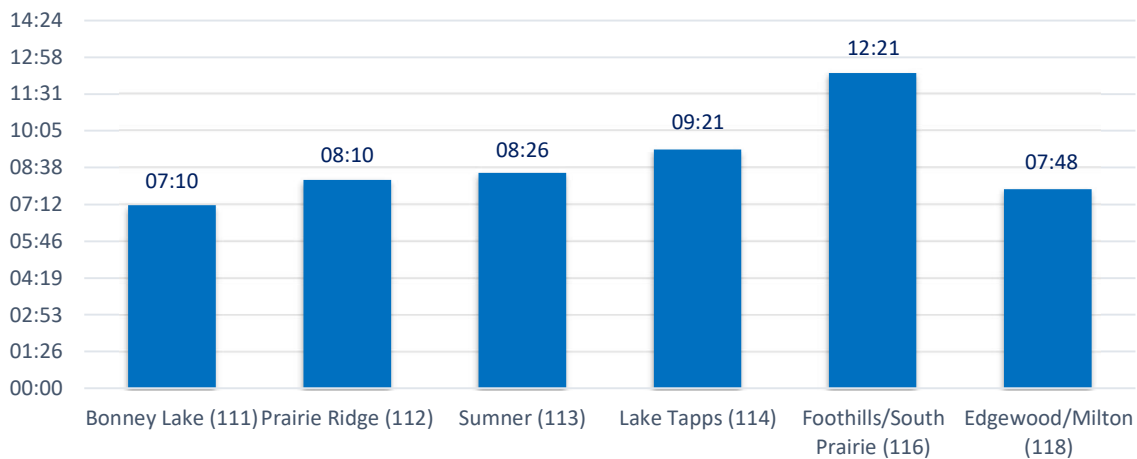

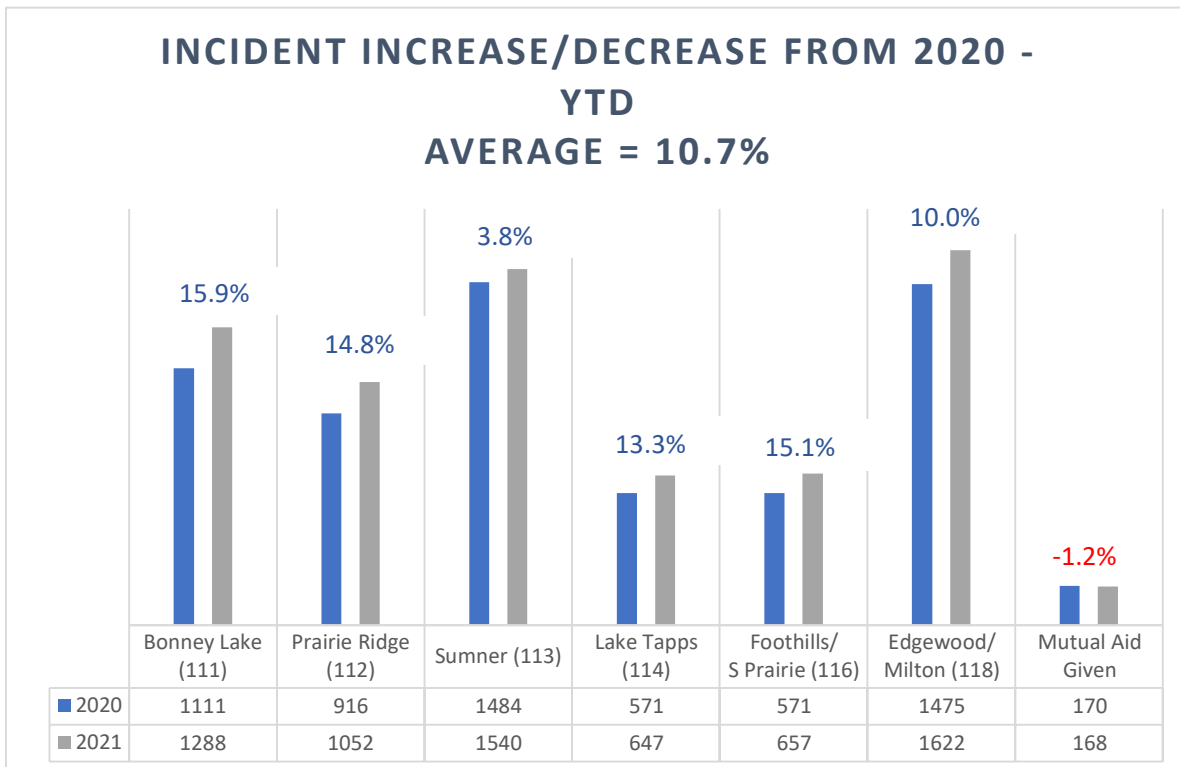
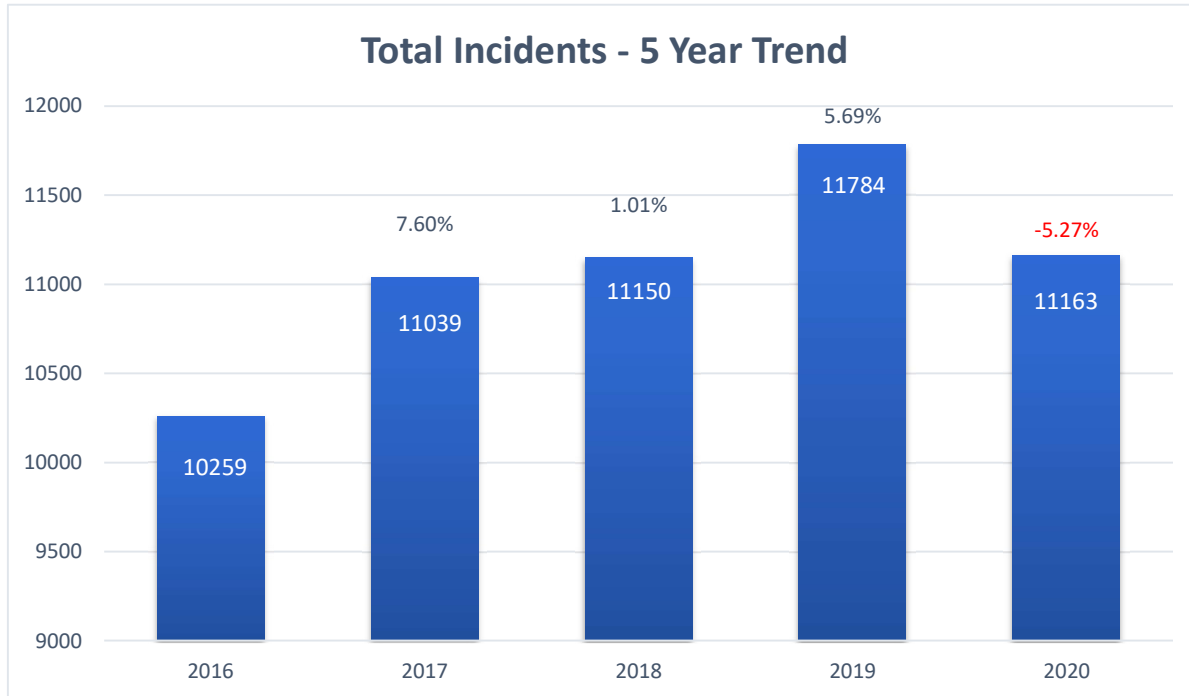


Average Response Time by Response Area - YTD

Measures time from dispatch to arrival of first unit

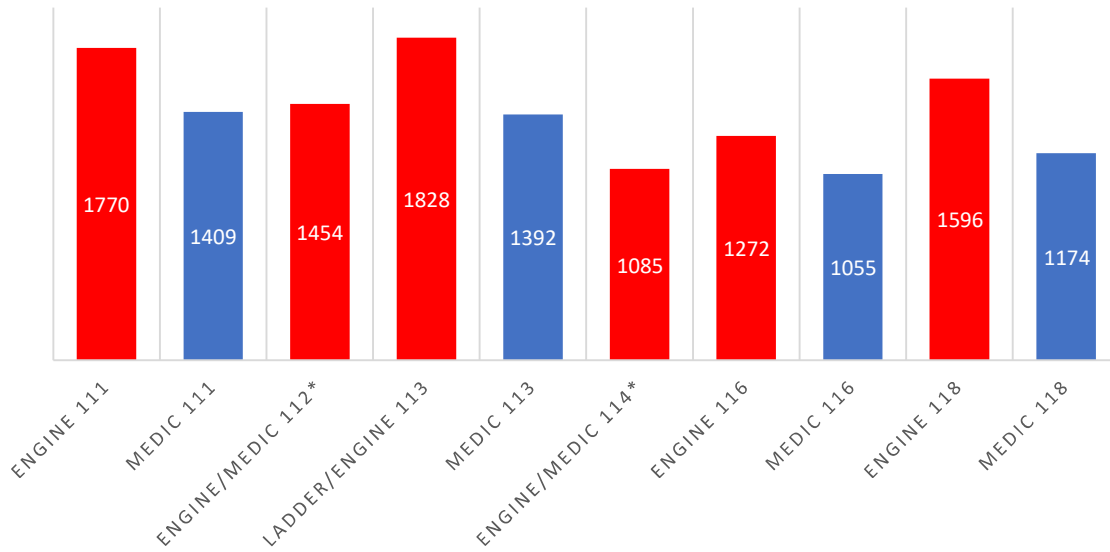
Average Response Time = 08:53



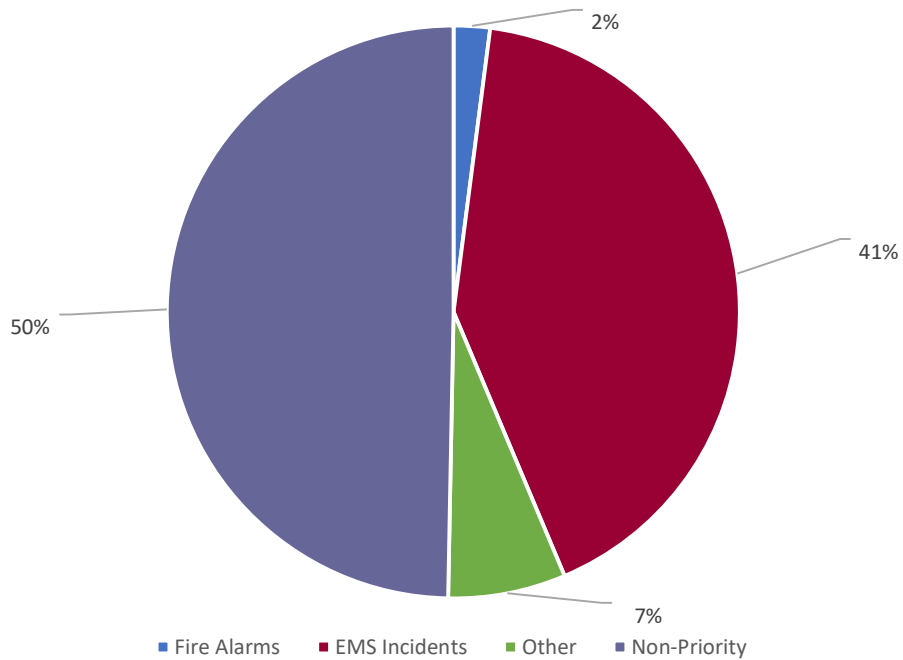


INCIDENTS BY UNIT - YTD

*NOTES CROSS-STAFFED UNITS

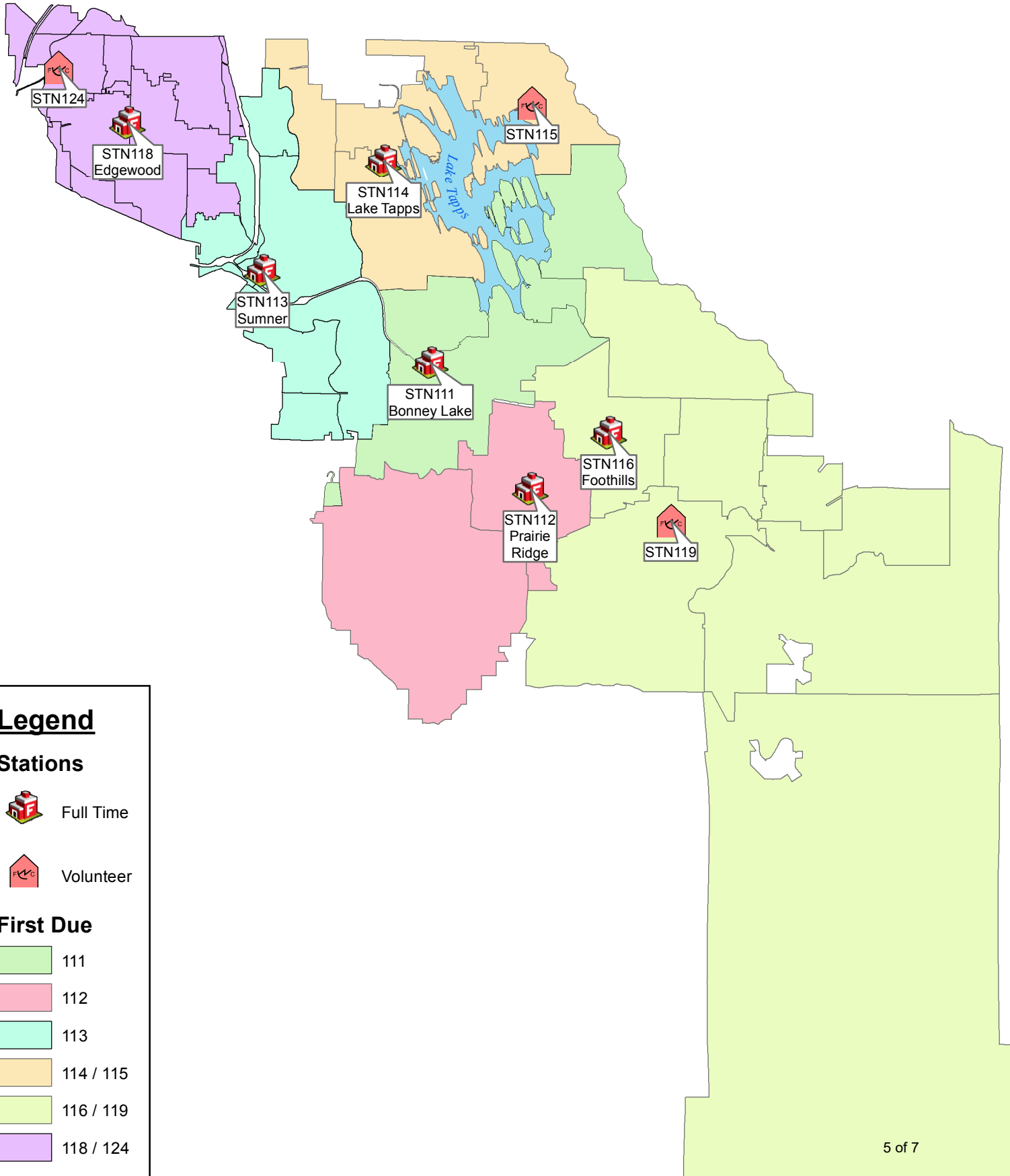
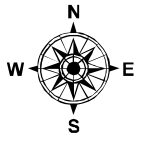


Incidents by Type - YTD

ORDINANCE NO. 2787
CITY OF SUMNER, WASHINGTON

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUMNER, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SUMNER MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 12.60.040K “GENERAL PARK, TRAIL, AND FACILITY RULES” RELATING TO THE RULES FOR THE CITY’S PARKS, TRAILS, AND FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, Sumner Municipal Code Chapter 12.60.040, “General park, trail, and facility rules” Section K outline the general rules of Sumner’s parks, trails and facilities; and

WHEREAS, from time to time, code provisions are reviewed and updated to refine language and to reflect modifications in policies, practices and state law so as to increase the clarity and effectiveness of the Sumner Municipal Code and ensure it remains compliant and enforceable;

WHEREAS, RCW [70.160.130](#) prohibits smoking in public places;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that the regulations regarding the rules of parks, trails and facilities be updated to more accurately reflect current needs of the community; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance was presented to the Community Development Committee during the July 28, 2021 meeting, during which the committee gave the ordinance a do-pass; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance was presented to the Public Safety Committee during the August 18, 2021 meeting, during which the committee gave the ordinance a do-pass.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUMNER, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 12.60.040K of the Sumner Municipal Code, “General park, trail, and facility rules” is hereby amended as follows;

K. No person shall open and/or consume any alcoholic beverages or open and/or consume any marijuana, marijuana-infused product, or marijuana concentrates (RCW [69.50.445](#)), or use tobacco products including but not limited to cigarettes, vapor electric cigarettes, cigars, pipes, or any other smoking device, or chewing tobacco in any public park, along the City’s trail system and property adjacent thereto, or within 25 feet of any City facility.

Section 2. Severability – Construction. If a section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction; such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. If the provisions of this ordinance are found to be inconsistent with other provisions of the Sumner Municipal Code, the provisions of this ordinance shall control.

Section 3. Corrections by City Clerk or Code Reviser. Upon approval of the City Attorney, the City Clerk and the Code Reviser are authorized to make the necessary corrections to this ordinance, including the correction of clerical errors; ordinance, section, or subsection numbering; or references to other local, state, or federal laws, codes, rules, or regulations.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days from and after its passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.
